Russ Daehling, Highway Supt., Mike Janssen, Building & Grounds Supt. and Sherry Schweitzer, County Clerk updated the Commissioners on activities of their offices.

**Commissioner's Reports:**

Commissioner Luebbe reported he visited some road shops the past week including the Missile Base shop where he inspected the actual Missile Base Silo. He also visited with Richard Knuth and Emrich Excavating about road projects.

Commissioner Garske had no report.

David Borgen, an attorney representing Richard Knuth was present to ask for a road project request. Mr. Knuth is requesting approval to apply Armor Coat/Seal Coat on Old Mill Road from Highway 15 for 1200 linear feet. Daehling stated that the cost would be approximately \$11,660.00 with a yearly maintenance cost of under \$3,000.00. The Road Dept. will perform the work on the road project. The cost of maintenance of the road would be paid by Knuth. The attorney will take the information to Knuth and the item will be discussed at a future meeting.

Moved by Koci and seconded by Luebbe to go into a Public Hearing at 9:40 a.m. to hear comments or concerns for the Seward County 1 & 6 Year Road Program.

Daehling then explained each project on the current 1 & 6 Year Road Program.

Duane Miner, representing Seward County Economic Development wanted to give his recommendation for hard surfacing the road into the Digitec business near Milford.

Cathy Miller wanted to know when a bridge near her was planned to be upgraded.

Darrell Carr suggested putting some roads on the 6 Year Road Plan.

Road Foreman Dave Pankoke also suggested some maintenance scheduled for the Bayer Crop Science Project.

Artie Lucas and Larry Goldberg of Goldberg Group Architects were present to discuss the proposed Justice Center Project. They had toured a large building South of Seward for a prospective site and also the current jail and made suggestions after taking a look at the properties.
