

Home Systems and Maintenance

This course will require each student to develop skills that they currently do not possess in the processes and techniques used in the construction industry. This class for the most part will be held at school but could possibly extended to off-site residential. The projects will be centered on residential construction, framing, interior/exterior finishing, siding, roofing, masonry, wiring, hvac and plumbing. Most of the class will be at school but my hope is to offer some on the job site experiences as well.

Student Responsibilities:

- I expect all students to be on time and prepared. If we go to job site, there is no excuse for being late to the job site. It will be your responsibility to have the proper clothing and equipment for the class.
- If we go off-site it will be your responsibility to get to and from the job site in a safe manner. Obey all traffic laws and make no stops along the way. If this becomes a problem your driving privileges will be taken away. You will be excused from the site when the instructor gives permission. Sometimes we might have to stay later than regular scheduled class time. Driving Sheet on other sheet will need to be signed.
- There will be NO swearing, vandalism, horseplay or other unsafe behaviors in class or at the job site. There is no place for such behavior and suspension from the class will occur.
- Come to class dressed in the proper attire. Having “nice shoes” on will not excuse you from your responsibilities. This is construction class, so you probably will get dirty.
- Safety to, at and from the site is a must. Students are expected to use their safety skills learned from Woods I and II. Unsafe behaviors will not be tolerated and removal from class will occur if not followed.
- You are expected to work in groups, help others, and will always be required to do something. Don’t become a spectator. Participation will be one of the largest portions of your grade.
- Clean-up: It is your responsibility to clean-up your area each and every day. Once finished with your area, please help out others.

Tools you will need: Since we have limited quantities of tools I suggest that each student bring their own, however if this is a problem let me know and I can check out tools to you.

- Tool pouch, either a leather double pouch or a canvas one.
- Hammer, anything between 16 and 20 oz. with a flat face will do.
- Tape Measure, 25 to 30 footer.
- Utility knife with extra blades.
- Speed square.
- Pencil
- Safety Glasses
- Chalk Line

Reminder: We could be working for a customer and just like with any job they expect the job completed correctly and to look nice. It is all of our jobs to see that the customer receives the finished product they were hoping for. Projects at school are no different; the school is paying for you to use these materials, so it will be your responsibility to do things correctly and not waste materials. You will also be required to tear down the equipment afterwards to be used in later classes.
